Please open all cartons immediately to ensure all material is on-site and undamaged.

Any claims must be filed within 15 days of receipt of product.

#### Please read all assembly and installation instructions of Feelux products

- Before attempting to install or use fixture, read and understand the following installation instructions and safety labels.
- 2. If you have any questions, please contact Feelux Lighting Technical Support at:

- 3. Feelux product must be installed by a licensed electrician in accordance with all National and Local Electrical and Construction Codes and Regulations.
- 4. Verify electrical plan.
- 5. Ensure the main power supply is off before installing or wiring fixtures.
- 6. Do not install a fixture if the unit, lens, housing or power cables are damaged.
- 7. Fixtures have no serviceable parts.
- 8. Do not use a fixture or driver for any voltage for which it is not rated.
- 9. Do not exceed the specified voltage, current or wattage for any fixture or driver
- 10. Feelux Lighting FLX Stix complies with Part 15 of the FCC rules. Class B Digital Apparatus complies with Canadian ICES-003.
- 11. Feelux FLX Stix fixtures are damp rated and closet approved.
- 12. Confirm that Driver/Transformer is compatible with fixtures and proposed dimming control system.
- 13. IMPORTANT NOTE FLX STIX NDV REQUIRES A POWER FEED AT EVERY 55W.

#### Feelux Lighting FLX Stix NDPro Installation Instructions

- 1. Feelux FLX Stix NDPro product requires a power feed for every 55W.
  - a. Side Feed units can be used for continuous, uninterrupted installation of lighting.
  - b. Side Feed units have factory installed power cable.
- 2. Splicing: NDPPC and Side Feed Power Cables are 8'.
  - a. If remote mount driver/power option is used
    - 1. Contractor to provide low voltage wire from driver/transformer to Power Cable.
  - b. Contractor must test for 24V signal at all splice points.
  - c. Polarity must be followed and is:
    - Lead: Gray Striped Negative
    - Lead: White Wire Positive
- 3. Feelux PTC Connecting Cables (Jumpers) cannot be modified.
- 4. NDV-Bracket3 MUST be used to support all junction points. This bracket is included with the fixture.
- 5. NDV-Bracket4 MUST be used to support connection, fixture to NDPPC and NDPPTC cables. The bracket is included.
- 6. Product cannot be installed via magnets when installing in downward position. Please check with factory for information.

# FLX Stix NDPro Installation Instructions

#### **Approved Drivers and Transformer**

The Drivers and Transformers listed below are approved for the Feelux FLX Stix Series:

- Feelux FLC, FLE, XLD and XLAV Series Drivers

- · Justin and Q-Tran: Please check with factory for availability
  - \*Please note when dimming that DC + Cap is required. Please check with factory.
- Please consult Feelux for additional power supply, driver and transformer options.

Please note that for FLC and XLD75, the FDC-L10 dimming interface is required. Please check with Feelux Lighting for additional Driver/Power Supply options. Using unapproved Driver/Power Supply may void warranty.

#### **Tips**

- 1. Make certain all surfaces are free of dirt and debris prior to installation.
- 2. Snap fixtures firmly together to ensure proper connection.
- 3. Bracket 3 must be used at all connection points.
- 4. Use mounting brackets for proper alignment.
- 5. After installation remove/blow off all construction dust and debris.
- 6. Fixtures must be protected from paint and paint splatter.

#### **Troubleshooting**

- 1. Check electrical and mechanical connections points.
- 2. Verify that connections are using brackets 3 & 4 to secure.
- 3. Is the fixture run over the maximum wattage/maximum run length?
- 4. Is the wattage exceeded for the driver?
- 5. Verify that polarity was followed if power cord spliced.
- 6. Check for voltage drop.
- 7. Is the driver being used the correct unit for the dimming control?

CAUTION: DO NOT EXCEED RATED WATTAGE OF PRODUCT OR DRIVER AT ANY TIME

#### **Mounting and Mounting Hardware**


FLX Stix Series are shipped with Standard Mounting Brackets and Magnetic Plates Angled Mounting Brackets are ordered separately.

Brackets are to be installed with 2" from ends of the unit to support the junction point.

For fixtures of 24" longer, install a 3rd mounting bracket near the center.


Bracket 3 is included and must be installed at all connection points.

### Align all brackets using laser line




#### Standard Mounting:

- 1. Assemble fixtures
- 2. Align / Install Brackets using laser line
- 3. Snap fixtures into brackets



Optional: Angled Brackets Brackets can be used 40 degree and 15 degree mounting positions.

- 1. Assemble fixtures
- 2. Align / Install Brackets using laser line
- Snap fixtures into Brackets 3.




Mounting Option: Magnetic Mounting with Metal Plates to be used ONLY on glass surfaces, ONLY on horizontal positions.

- 1. Assemble fxtures
- 2. Place Metal Plates on magnets in the back of the fixtures
- Peel off double stick tape 3.
- Holding the fixtures press the exposed tape side to the glass surface

Mounting Option: Magnetic Mounting for use on ferrous metal surfaces.

- 1. Assemble fixtures
- Snap fixtures onto ferrous metal surface






- 1. CUT POWER FEED CABLE, NDPPC BEHIND CONNECTOR AS SHOWN.

- 3. POLARITY MUST BE FOLLOWED: LEAD: GRAY STRIPES - NEGATIVE LEAD: WHITE WIRE - POSITIVE




# Wiring FEELUX Dimming Signal Interface, FDC-L10 to Power Feed Cable, NDPPC






## Feelux XLD75 Driver, Dimming Signal Interface FDC-L10 and 12-port HUB and Hardwire Driver
